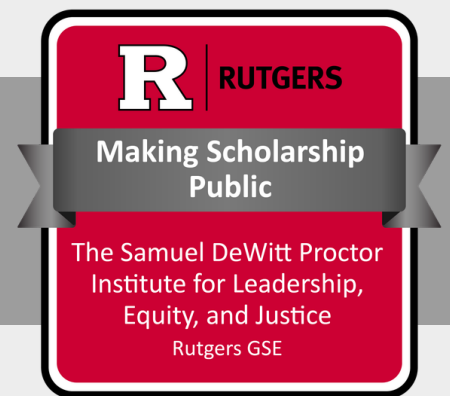


MAKING SCHOLARSHIP PUBLIC WEBINAR SERIES
