

# DOING THE RIGHT THING

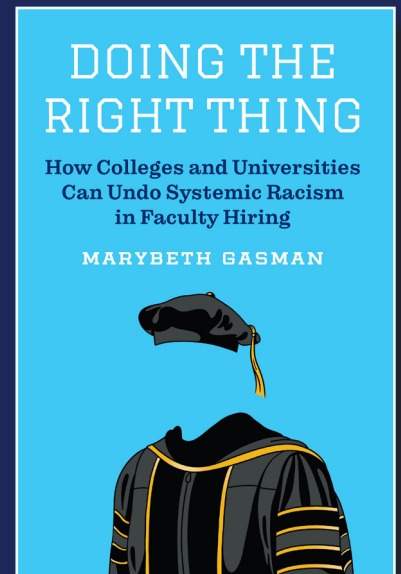
